The highest-ranking nominees will be recommended to become an Award Recipient in addition to being acknowledged at LACAAEA's Annual Black History Month Black-Tie Gala & Fundraiser, on Saturday, February 22, 2025 at the Omni Hotel, Downtown Los Angeles.
